**Schedule of payments and financial aid:**

**October 31, 2008** - Nonrefundable administrative fee of \$100 due to CIS

**November 3, 2008** - Full payment of program fee due to EF Tours

Matriculated students seeking financial aid to cover program cost must contact the Center for International Studies by October 17, 2008.

Individuals may request to be put on a waiting list if a payment deadline has passed or maximum number of trip participants has been reached.

**Registration and payment:**

Administrative fee must be accompanied by Travelearn Participant Form, Travel Waiver, and copy of passport. Administrative fee may be made by check or money order payable to Kean University; payments made by credit card are acceptable but must be processed at least one day prior to due date in order to confirm approval. Cash payments will not be accepted.

**Other information (credit, insurance, etc.):**

While individuals may go on the tour without registering for credit, individuals who wish to receive credit must register for the academic course(s) prior to trip start date.
